Walk Reclaimed is a nonprofit created to fight against human trafficking with a specific focus on providing housing and care for boys. People usually don't think of boys as the victims of sex trafficking, but it is all too common, and places to help these boys are virtually nonexistent.

Our mission is to provide shelter, love and support to male survivors of sex trafficking, to give hope to boys who have forgotten what hope feels like.

We received our 501(c)(3) tax exempt status from the IRS August 15, 2016 making any donations tax deductible.
